VERA HOFMANN (*1979 in Gießen) lives in Berlin. After SABINE SCHRÜNDER (*1973 in Telgte) lives in Berlin. graduation in 2009 in photo design at Lette-Verein Berlin, Hofmann works mainly with photography in combination with video, object and installation. She also holds a BA in Business Administration from BA Mannheim and has worked for several years in renowned advertising agencies like Scholz & Friends and Young & Rubicam. Characteristic of her artistic practice is a complex approach to both context and form, shaped by a curious, examining and critical view within the fields of politics, economy and society. Her work has been awarded and displayed in various exhibitions nationally and internationally and is represented in collections as House of Photography, Burghausen and Foundation F.C. Gundlach, Hamburg.

Since her graduation from FH Bielefeld Schründer works mainly with photography and video on socio-cultural topics, in particular the place of the individual in society, how society works in predetermined structures and the dynamics between groups and individuals. Her projects received the highly renowned scholarship "Stipendium für zeitgenössische deutsche Fotografie" of the Alfried Krupp von Bohlen and Halbach Foundation, the Aenne-Biermann award, Reinhard-Wolf award and was nominated for the Körber-Foto award and the Japanese Ina Nobuo Award. Together with other visual artists she founded Loris- gallery for contemporary art 2007 in Berlin. Her installative works are exhibited regularly nationally and internationally including the Museum Folkwang in Essen, the House of Photography in Hamburg, the Contemporary Art Center Vilnius, Museum of Art Arsenals in Riga and the Nikon-Salon in Tokyo.
